FROM THE NAVIGATOR

After passing north of the position of Titanic in the early hours of the morning, QUEEN MARY 2 continued along her great circle course across the North Atlantic Ocean. Today we will pass over the Flemish Cap which is a shallow bank made famous by the 2000 film "The Perfect Storm". We will also pass north of the Milne Bank, a very shallow depth of 102 metres in the otherwise deep surrounding waters of 3,100 metres.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

Nautical twilight is a period in the morning and evening when the sun is between 6 and 12 degrees below the horizon. Some visible light is present, but not enough to conduct detailed activities without the use of artificial light, and the horizon tends to be somewhat indistinct during this period. People refer to this time of day as "nautical twilight" to reference the fact that sailors often took navigational observations during this time, since the visibility was ideal. In the morning, people may refer to nautical twilight as "first light," the period when light first begins to be visible and the sky slowly starts to flush with colour as the sun comes up.

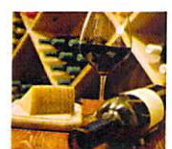

To respect all guests on board QUEEN MARY 2 all public spaces are designated as non-smoking within the ship, with the exception of G32 from 9.00pm (port side upper level only) and Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Outside, on the open decks, the starboard side of the aft end of the ship on Deck 8, under the canopy and on Deck 7 aft under the clock are designated as smoking areas. All restaurants are non-smoking, this includes outdoor dining alternatives. Smoking is not permitted in staterooms or on stateroom balconies. Churchill's is a lounge dedicated to cigar and pipe smokers all day. The extensive cigar selection is stored in the built-in humidor area. Electronic cigarettes which do not emit smoke are not permitted in public areas, but can be used in designated smoking areas and on stateroom balconies. We kindly ask you to respect this policy for the safety and comfort of our guests.

VISITING THE BRIDGE

We receive many requests for visits to the bridge. Unfortunately for both security and operational reasons we are unable to accommodate these requests. However we do have a viewing area behind the Bridge which can be accessed on Deck 12 via A Stairway on the port side. The viewing area is normally open on all sea days between 9.00am and 4.00pm. The area may be closed on some days for operational reasons. Photography and video cameras are prohibited, and we ask that you do not bring food and drink into the area. We also request that whilst in the viewing area you remain quiet. Thank you for your co-operation and enjoy the view.

HAND ANTISEPTIC UNITS IN KINGS COURT

We encourage you to assist us in retaining a healthy ship by using the hand antiseptic before proceeding to the self-service buffet. Dispensers are located next to the serving trays. We also encourage you to replace serving tongs on the plates after each use. Please note that the use of these hand sanitisers should not be considered as a replacement for hand washing. Thorough and frequent hand washing is the most effective method of preventing the spread of person to person viral infection, and we encourage you to wash your hands at every opportunity.
