### NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

The country in which a ship is registered is indicated by a flag known as an ensign. Traditionally, this flag is flown from the gaff, which extends from the top of the foremast, just aft of the bridge, when at sea or the staff on the stern of a ship whilst alongside a quay. When hoisting the ensign, a sailor must be very careful and ensure it is flown the right way up. An ensign flown upside-down traditionally indicated distress aboard a vessel, usually mutiny!

## CREDIT CARD REGISTRATION AND CASH PAYMENTS

For guests disembarking in Southampton on 10 January please note the deadline of 11.00pm tomorrow, 9 January for the following services:

- Changing the credit card registered to your on board account.
- Making a cash payment. After this deadline, all charges will be settled to the registered credit card. Please be advised that no cash will be refunded to your credit card.
- Charging cash back and/or foreign exchange to your on board account.

Cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until time of disembarkation on 10 January.

Guests disembarking and settling their accounts in cash will need to visit the Purser's Office anytime before disembarking to finalise their account. Please note that failure to settle your account will result in delays to your disembarkation.

## SMOKING POLICY

To respect all guests on board QUEEN MARY 2 all public spaces are designated as non-smoking within the ship, with the exception of G32 from 6.00pm (port side upper level only) and Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Outside, on the open decks, the starboard side of the aft end of the ship on Deck 8, under the canopy and on Deck 7 aft under the clock are designated as smoking areas. All restaurants are non-smoking, this includes outdoor dining alternatives. Smoking is not permitted in staterooms or on stateroom balconies.
