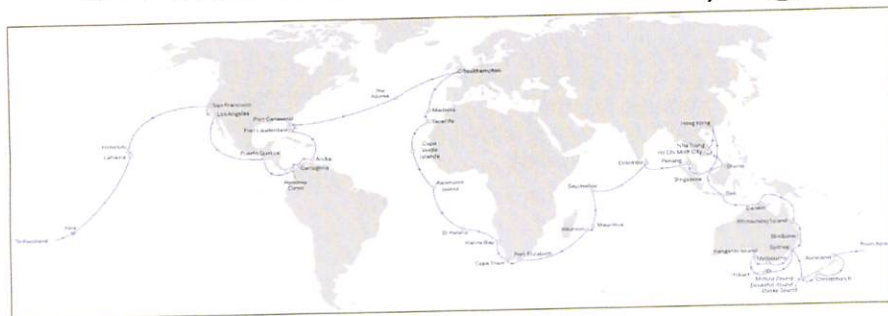

Queen Victoria sets sail on her 2016 World Voyage



The Port of Southampton

All Aboard Time: 5.30pm

During 1911, Cunard Line purchased three ships, renamed the Albania, Ausonia and Ascania, to begin a new service between London, Southampton and Canada. The route was intended to take advantage of a treaty signed between the Canadian and French governments whereby goods shipped to Canada through a British port received a rebate. Cargo was loaded in Tilbury Docks, London, and passengers joined the ship in Southampton, which then proceeded to Quebec and Montreal. This new route was pioneered by the Albania, which arrived in Southampton for the first time on 2 May 1911, beginning a long relationship between Cunard and Southampton. Cunard's headquarters remain in Southampton, now in the modern surroundings of Carnival House.

Restaurant seating

Your restaurant assignment is according to the type of stateroom or suite booked. A seating card will be placed in your stateroom or suite during embarkation. To assist you in finding your way around QUEEN VICTORIA, be advised that the Port side of the ship has even numbered staterooms, while the Starboard side has odd numbered staterooms. This is the same on all floors with accommodations. Our stairways are lettered: A is forward, B is midships, and C is aft. Additionally, there are maps of the ship as well as directional signs placed near the lifts. We hope this assists in becoming familiar with our ship during your voyage.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your "Cruise Card" with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. It may be prudent that you also have a Government issued picture ID with you before leaving the ship, as you may be required to show this at security checkpoints upon your return. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your cruise card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the security staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Guests under 16 years of age

Children under the age of 16 years old must not be left on board unaccompanied by a Parent or Guardian. The ship's staff cannot take responsibility for children left on board and if a child is not going ashore, a Parent/Guardian must remain with them at all times. Passengers under 16 years old are not permitted to disembark the ship in any port without a passenger aged 18 years or over who is accompanying them on their voyage booking.

Jacket required, tie optional for gentlemen, cocktail dress, stylish separates or equivalent for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women); sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Important notice: health advice

Should you experience any symptoms of vomiting or diarrhoea, please report this by telephone immediately to the Medical Centre from your stateroom by dialling 999/911. We ask for your cooperation preventing the possible spread of this illness and recommend that when practical you use the bathroom in your stateroom. It is vitally important that everyone on board maintains excellent standards of personal hygiene as the virus is easily passed on from person to person by touching surfaces such as handrails, door handles and elevator buttons. The single most effective means of prevention is frequent and thorough hand-washing. We recommend that you wash your hands using soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds then rinse and dry them well each time you use the toilet/restroom, after coughing or sneezing and before eating, drinking or smoking. Please try to avoid touching your mouth with your hands. Whilst alcohol hand sanitisers are no substitute for hand-washing, these have been provided for your use in certain food service areas around the ship.

General emergency drill

It is a requirement of law that all guests are exercised in the ship's general emergency procedures before the ship leaves her berth today. This drill will take place at 4.00pm today. Prior to attending this drill we would like to bring your attention to the safety notice on or near the back of your door and ask that you view the safety film which is showing continuously on stateroom TV channel 48.

Internet centre

The internet service will open for all users at approximately 6.00pm. Packages may be purchased after that time. ConneXions 1 located on deck 1 in the Grand Lobby and the Internet Centre located in the Library, deck 3 are open 24 hours. Assistance will be provided until 8.30pm this evening for guest queries in ConneXions 1. Cunard World Club Card members are required to first purchase their complimentary packages, and they will automatically be refunded by the Purser's Office.

US Dollars, Euros and GB Pounds are available at the Purser's Office. QUEEN VICTORIA only accepts denominations that we trade in as per the company guidelines.

Use of lifts

We advise all guests to be cautious of automated lift doors and we ask that parents do not allow unaccompanied children of less than 12 years of age to use the lifts. Lifts are not to be used in an emergency situation.

Postage

A Concierge Postal Service is available for you to send letters and postcards in every port. The rate per letter/postcard for this voyage is \$1.40 this rate covers worldwide postage. If you have already purchased your own postage stamps you may leave the mail at the Purser's Office for posting. Be advised that the deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked and 3 hours when we are at anchor.

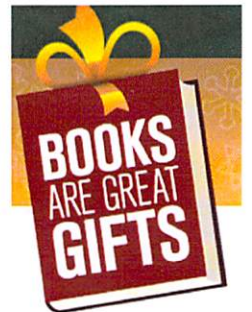


