From the navigator

After departing Southampton yesterday evening, QUEEN VICTORIA proceeded down Southampton water with the advice from the local pilot. Once clear of the isle of Wight we disembarked the local pilot and set south westerly courses through the English channel. Today QUEEN VICTORIA will maintain her south westerly courses towards Ponta Delgada. This morning at around 8.00am we passed Ile Du Ouessant which is the most north western tip of France at 51 nautical miles. Later this evening we will begin our transit of the Bay Of Biscay.

Nautical fact of the day

A bulbous bow is a protruding bulb at the bow (or front) of a ship just below the waterline. The bulb modifies the way the water flows around the hull, reducing drag and thus increasing speed, range, fuel efficiency, and stability. Large ships with bulbous bows generally have a twelve to fifteen percent better fuel efficiency than similar vessels without them. Bulbous bows have been found to be most effective when used in vessels that meet two conditions: the waterline length is longer than about 15 metres (49 ft), and the vessel will operate with most of its time at or near its maximum speed.

Underage drinking and gambling

Please understand that you may be requested to show identification indicating date of birth.

Tonight's dress code: informal

Jacket required, tie optional for gentlemen, cocktail dress, stylish separates or equivalent for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women); sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Any guests wishing to dress more casually are welcome to dine in the Lido buffet on deck 9 and relax in the Winter Garden, but should not use other areas within the ship, including our Alternative Dining Restaurants, out of respect for their fellow guests.

Hand antibacterial units in the Lido

We encourage all of our guests to assist us in retaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial before proceeding in to the buffet area. Dispensers are located at the entrances to the buffet area.

Toilets

QUEEN VICTORIA, as with most modern ships, has a vacuum operated toilet system. The pipe work of this system is much smaller than that used ashore. Whilst it is eminently suitable for its designed purpose, sanitary items, paper hand towels and items that are not rapidly biodegradable will cause obstructions. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

Postage

A Concierge Postal Service is available for you to send letters and postcards in every port. The rate per letter/postcard for this voyage is \$1.40 this rate covers worldwide postage. If you have already purchased your own postage stamps you may leave the mail at the Purser's Office for posting. Be advised that the deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked and 3 hours when we are at anchor.

For your safety and comfort we kindly request all bathers to shower before entering the pools.

Swimming pool information

The Pavilion swimming pool is for the enjoyment of all our guests where the Lido swimming pool is reserved for guests aged 16 and over.

We ask that all guests adhere to the following points of safety:

- Please observe and adhere to the pool rules by each pool. There are no lifeguards on duty and the pools can be deep and dangerous.
- Diving and jumping into the pools is strictly prohibited.
- The hot tubs on board are unsupervised and are relatively powerful and deep. We strongly advise that they are not used by those under 8 years of age and that under 16 years of age are accompanied by a Parent or a Guardian.
- Due to public health regulations, children in nappies, swim nappies, pull ups, or those who are not completely toilet trained are not allowed in the pools or whirlpools.
