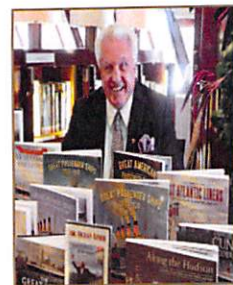

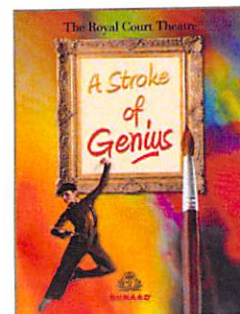

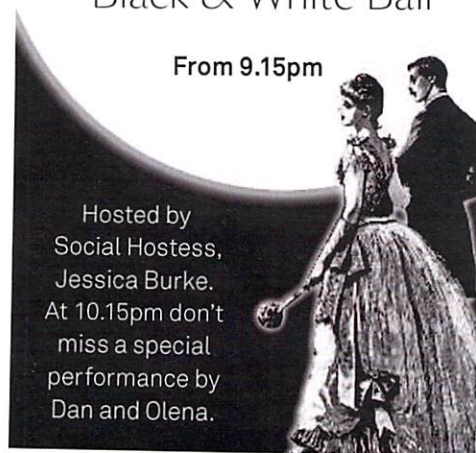

Under-age drinking and gambling

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them. You must also be 18 or above (21 in US ports and territorial waters) to be in the Casino or Hemispheres nightclub. Please understand that you may be requested to show identification indicating date of birth.

Dinner jacket, tuxedo or dark suit with tie for gentlemen. A range of gentlemen's formal wear is available to hire on board ship. Evening or cocktail dress for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women); sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Any guests wishing to dress more casually are welcome to dine in the Lido buffet on deck 9 and relax in the Winter Garden, but should not use other areas within the ship, including our Alternative Dining Restaurants, out of respect for their fellow guests.

Hand antibacterial units in the Lido

We encourage all of our guests to assist us in retaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial before proceeding in to the buffet area. Dispensers are located at the entrances to the buffet area.

Crew emergency drill

At 10.00am this morning, alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise, limited guest services will be provided. You are advised that part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated. If you will be in your stateroom during the drill and prefer not to be disturbed, please display the "do not disturb" notice prior to the start of the drill. Guests are strongly encouraged to broaden their knowledge of maritime safety by watching the programme shown on channel 48 of your stateroom television between 9.00am and 12.00pm. For the duration of the crew drill we request that guests keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck area.

All users of the guest laundrettes are kindly requested not to leave their laundry in the machines for long periods of time, but to take it out shortly after the washing or drying cycle has finished. This gives everybody the chance to use the washing machines and dryers.

Smoking policy change

Smoking is not permitted in staterooms, on balconies or in public areas. Designated areas of the open deck where smoking is permitted are on the starboard side of decks 3 and 10 only. Electronic cigarettes, including those which do not emit smoke, are not permitted in public areas but can be used in staterooms, on balconies and designated areas of the open deck. This change has been made for the safety and comfort of our guests and means that all will be able to enjoy full use of all areas of the ship, and their private balconies, without the effect of drifting smoke.
