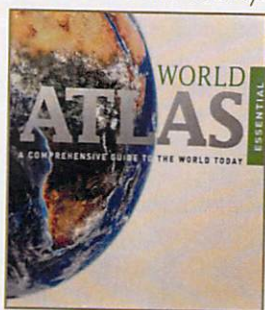

This evening we will let go our mooring lines and once clear of the breakwater, continue on a westerly heading across the North Atlantic ocean.

Officer Profile:

Captain Peter Philpott.

Captain Peter Philpott grew up in Folkestone in Kent and first went to sea on the cargo ships of London and Overseas Freighters Ltd as a Deck Cadet at the age of 17. He subsequently progressed up the Officer ranks as far as Chief Officer in a cargo company named Louis Dreyfuss Lines by the age of 27. At this time he switched to the cruise industry, joining P&O Cruises as a Second Officer in 1989. His first P&O ship was the Sea Princess (later named Victoria) and he went on to serve on several Princess Cruises vessels before being promoted to Staff Captain on Oceana in 2002. Captain Philpott's first command was the Artemis in March 2007 and he has since had spells on Oceana, Pacific Sun (for P&O Australia), Ocean Village Two and in 2010 Aurora. For 2011 and the early part of 2012 he was in command of Arcadia. He is the first and only Carnival UK Captain to take a company vessel (Artemis) down into Antarctic waters, when that vessel spent three days cruising there early in 2008, during the South American sector of her yearly Grand Voyage. Captain Philpott is delighted to have the pleasure of the command of QUEEN VICTORIA and welcomes our guests onto what is surely one of the finest passenger liners in the world today. When at home on leave in the beautiful Cotswold's in the South West of England, Captain Philpott likes to spend time enjoying the house and garden, catching up with family, walking the dog, exploring more of the history and attractions that his own country has to offer and is a keen follower of most sports.

Under-age drinking and gambling.

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them. You must also be 18 or above (21 in US ports and territorial waters) to be in the Casino or Hemispheres nightclub. Please understand that you may be requested to show identification indicating date of birth.

Tonight's dress code: informal.

Jacket required, tie optional for gentlemen, cocktail dress, stylish separates or equivalent for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women); sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Any guests wishing to dress more casually are welcome to dine in the Lido buffet on deck 9 and relax in the Winter Garden, but should not use other areas within the ship, including our Alternative Dining Restaurants, out of respect for their fellow guests.

Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

Entering the US: ESTA and Visa requirements.

Guests of the following nationalities who are not in possession of a valid US Visa are required to have an ESTA. If you did not apply for an ESTA yet, please do so via www.usavisaonline.com/esta in order to ensure a smooth immigration inspection upon arrival into Port Canaveral on Thursday, 21 January 2016. If you are in possession of a valid US visa (B1/B2 or other type of visa) please advise the Purser's Office on extension 33000 no later than 12.00pm (noon) on Monday, 18 January 2016.

The following nationalities are eligible to apply for the ESTA: Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Czech Republic*, Denmark, Estonia*, Finland, France, Germany, Greece*, Hungary*, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia*, Liechtenstein, Lithuania*, Luxembourg, Malta*, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia*, Slovenia, South Korea*, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan and United Kingdom.

*Indicates that those passports must be biometric to be eligible to apply for an ESTA.

Guests identification cards.

Be aware that your ship ID card is magnetised. These cards can easily become de-magnetised if they are held next to another magnet, for example a credit card, magnets on a handbag, mobile phones, cameras, or if two identification cards are held next to one another.

Mobile phones.

Out of respect for your fellow diners, guests are requested to refrain from using mobile phones or other communication devices in the restaurants.

Alcohol bought ashore.

When purchasing alcohol ashore, please remember that this may be brought on board the ship for consumption in staterooms only and may not be taken into the public areas or on the open decks.

Environmental notice.

White star luggage.
