Postage.

For your convenience a Concierge Postal Service is available for you to send letters and postcards in every port. The rate per letter/postcard for this voyage is \$1.40, this rate covers worldwide postage. If you have already purchased your own postage stamps you may leave the mail at the Purser's Office for posting. Be advised that the deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked and 3 hours when we are at anchor.

Currency exchange.

US Dollars, Euros, and GB Pounds are available at the Purser's Office. Queen Victoria only accept denominations that we trade in as per the company guidelines. Please be advised that any cash back and/or foreign exchange is only available for charging to the on board account until 11.00pm today, Thursday, 21 January, however cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until the time of disembarkation tomorrow, Friday, 22 January.

Passport information.

Guests do not need to carry passports ashore today in the port of Port Canaveral, your Queen Victoria guest identification card is sufficient. It is however, recommended that you carry some form of photographic identification such as a copy of your passport or a Driver's License.

Complimentary shuttle bus service.

There will be a limited complimentary shuttle bus transfer service from Queen Victoria. There will be 2 drop off points, Cocoa Village and the Merrit Mall. The first bus will depart at 8.30am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 30 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Victoria will leave Merrit Mall at 6.00pm. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. We anticipate long queues for the first hour, and so some guests may wish to consider using a local taxi to avoid waiting. For your information, it is possible to walk into town (approximately 15 minutes walk).

Security and safety ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets and handbags.
- We advise you to be extremely careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.

Wheelchair assistance for shore excursions.

Guests are kindly reminded that wheelchair assistance (if required) will be provided to assist guests on and off the gangway only. As per the terms and conditions stated in the Cunard brochure, guests must be able to make their own way to the transportation on the pier, or be accompanied by a travel companion who is able to assist them.

Jacket required, tie optional for gentlemen, cocktail dress, stylish separates or equivalent for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women); sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

We encourage all of our guests to assist us in maintaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units that are at the gangway.

Voyage questionnaire prize draw.

We kindly ask that you fill in your guest questionnaire form and place it in the drop box provided at the Purser's Office. The lucky winner whose name is drawn out of the box will have their accumulated bar charges from this sector up until the time of the draw, paid for with the compliments of Cunard. The prize draw will take place today before dinner at 6.00pm. It will be announced over the public address system.

Luggage tags.

All Independent guests with their own arrangements will re-use their embarkation label for disembarkation (the label you used to embark Queen Victoria). Any additional or replacement luggage tags can be obtained from your Bedroom Steward.

Crew emergency drill.

At approximately 10.00am this morning, alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise, limited guest services will be provided. You are advised that part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated. If you will be in your stateroom during the drill and prefer not to be disturbed, please display the "do not disturb" notice prior to the start of the drill. Guests are strongly encouraged to broaden their knowledge of maritime safety by watching the programme shown on channel 48 of your stateroom television between 9.00am and 12.00pm. For the duration of the crew drill we request that guests keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck area.

Guests disembarking on Friday, 22 January.

We kindly ask all guests disembarking in Fort Lauderdale, on Friday, 22 January to vacate their staterooms by 8.30am at the latest, in order for the Housekeeping Team to be able to have all staterooms/suites ready for the embarking guests.

Internet centre.

The internet centre will be closed for new purchases from 9.00pm. No purchases or printing can be made after that time. Any remaining minutes can be used until 10.30am tomorrow morning.

Under-age drinking and gambling.

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them. You must also be 18 or above (21 in US ports and territorial waters) to be in the Casino or Hemispheres nightclub. Please understand that you may be requested to show identification indicating date of birth.

Self-help disembarkation.

If you wish to disembark early prior to the main disembarkation and are able bodied and capable of carrying ALL of your own luggage, you can apply for Self Help Disembarkation at the Purser's Office. You will be issued a Self Help card which you will be required to present at the gangway when leaving the ship. When disembarking Self Help, you do not require luggage labels, please keep all of your luggage in your stateroom overnight and meet in the Queens Room, Deck 2, Midships with your luggage. Self Help disembarkation is expected to commence at 7.15am.
